Dear Ms. Chernyshenko,

My name is [REDACTED], I attended your webinar "How to find a job?" today. After asking a question at the end of the webinar I did not have enough time to write feedback in the chat, so I decided to write you an email.

First, I would like to thank you for providing your expertise to students like me. As a student with a still limited network and few financial resources, this kind of advice can be hard to come by and I appreciate your effort for our generation immensely.

I found the webinar very insightful and wish I had heard it during the beginning of my academic career rather than now when I am about to graduate. But I am convinced, that it will still be of great help to me in my future career. I believe that especially for young students your tips were something completely new.

Personally, I had heard another seminar about a year ago, that was similar in some regards. For example, the method of searching for key terms and phrases in job descriptions and then matching them with one's own skills and experiences was something that I had already heard. But using a SWOT Analysis for analysing oneself was a new concept for me and I will certainly use it in the future. Especially the idea of using opportunities and weaknesses to showcase one's ability to grow and improve or as a Storytime during an interview is brilliant. I believe with this technique I can show a lot more of my personality in future interviews.

The most useful advice for me was the segment about how to use LinkedIn correctly. I have had a LinkedIn account for several years, but never really understood how I could use it to further my career, other than to post my CV and look for job opportunities.

After your webinar I have set a goal for myself to write to at least 5 people today and 20 more this weekend. Previously I had written to two or three people without receiving a reply and was immediately discouraged. I understand now that my approach was likely not perfect and I simply gave up too soon. In the future I will use your template message and ask more specific questions.

What I especially liked about the webinar was that for all the tips and frameworks you presented to us, you had specific stories, examples and templates. I often struggle to adapt advice to my personal situation. But when I see a framework that is already filled in or an example message, I process the advice more efficiently.
